Topics include, but are not limited to the following.

- Review the organization of a typical set of constructions drawings
- Review the drawing content of the ASM&E disciplines
- Use the cross referencing symbols to help find specific information
- Interpret basic information found on mechanical and electrical drawings
- Interpret more detailed information found on architectural and structural drawings
- Extract information from drawings to prepare a partial quantity takeoff
- Review the organization of a project manual (specifications)
- Find and interpret information found in a project manual
- Consider the relationship of drawings and project manual
- Consider the link between quantity takeoffs and cost estimating
- Consider the impact of the project manual on cost estimating
